### DONORSCHOOSE AND TEACHER RETENTION:

Recent studies show that having a project funded through DonorsChoose makes a teacher 22% less likely to leave in a given school year. This finding supports the statement that providing individualized resources selected by teachers through crowdfunding reduces the likelihood that they will leave the profession.

# READOKC

## **READING CHALLENGES:**

Students have logged over 29.1 million minutes and over 44,000 students have met the goal of reading 20 minutes a day or more over school breaks.
