READING CHALLENGES:

Since 2017, students have logged over 35.1 million minutes and over 54,000 students have met the goal of reading 20 minutes a day or more over school breaks.

ACCESS:

- Over 32,000 books distributed through ReadOKC On the Go! since July 2021

READING BUDDIES:

Recruiting and training efforts for the 2023-24 school year will take place over the summer. The goal is to place at least 200 volunteers into schools to serve as Reading Buddies and Book Club leaders.
