Bilingual and Diversity Program

OKCPS Bilingual and /or BIPOC paraprofessionals that are part of the Bilingual and Diversity Teacher Pipelines are supported by private funding through the OKCPS Foundation, which provides a wealth of resources to help them navigate full time jobs, take care of their families and attend college to earn their degrees. Colleges and university partnerships with OSU-OKC, OCCC, Rose State College and UCO also play a key role as these paraprofessionals earn their credits first at a community college and completing their degree at UCO. All tuition, fees and books are completely covered by the Foundation (after any applicable FAFSA).

- Must be an Oklahoma City Public Schools (OKCPS) employee for a minimum of one year and be classified as a paraprofessional.
- Must commit to teaching in OKCPS for a minimum of three years after certification.
