READING CHALLENGES:

Since 2017, students have logged over 44 million minutes and over 67,000 students have met the goal of reading 20 minutes a day or more over school breaks.

ACCESS:

- ALL Schools Now Have a Little Free Library
- Over 50,000 books distributed through ReadOKC On the Go! since July 2021

READING BUDDIES:

85 Reading Buddies serving at 21 Elementary Schools.
 15 Book Club leaders serving at 11 Middle and High Schools.

ReadOKC actively recruits volunteers for all programs year-round. With increased interest from schools in the Reading Buddies and Book Club programs and the addition of the second ReadOKC On the Go! book bus, more volunteers are needed now than ever.
